The AMA Racing Speedway National Championship Grand Final

The 2014 AMA National Championship Speedway Grand Final combines the best of traditional and modern Speedway formats. Our program begins the 20-heat main events and then two semifinals Championship round and then the Big Grand Final.

Here's how it works:

The main Round is a traditional 20-heat, 16-rider championship format in which every rider meets each of his 15 rivals at least once. First place will earn 3 points; second place will earn 2 points, 1 point for third place and 0 for fourth place.

Then the top 8 points scores will be elevated into the semifinals 1 and 2 with the top scores picking gate position first in each semi.

The racers that finish first and second place in each semi will be included in the National Championship Grand Final. The rider with most series total points after the tonight and the last two above mention rounds will become National Champion. In case of tie, the rider with highest finish in tonight's final would become National Champion and remember it is a possibility the winner of the final may not have enough total points to become the AMA Racing Speedway National Series Champion.

Once again, I welcome you to tonight's event and remind you of our exciting USA vs. The World season finale on Friday night October 10 here at Fast Fridays Motorcycle Speedway. We already have a great rider line up of both American team and international stars who will contest this great event on the world side
